

## BUENOS AIRES EXCURSIONS

### COOKING PATAGONICO

Stories, customs, tastes, crops, inherited wine & food pairings, are the main actors of this experience. Upon arrival guests will be offered a welcome cocktail, and be led to the kitchen with chef's hat and apron. A main dish, a receipt are our aim, that we will prepare all together, between bouquet, scent and taste of Patagonia.

### RIVER FLY FISHING

Limay River is one of the most celebrate rivers in Northern Patagonia. Enormous hatches of mayflies or caddies are typical in spring, when dry flies and nymphs are the best option for catching hungry rainbow trouts. Just 30 km. distance from Bariloche city center, or 60 km from Llao LLao Hotel.

### LAKE FLY FISHING

The beauty and purity of isolated Patagonian landscapes make it the ideal location to disconnect from the stress of urban lifestyle and capture one of the most combative fish that exist: the trout.

The specialized guide will be able to offer you a supreme service to this experience.



### SKI WITH LOCALS

Skiing comfortably and enjoying the journey. This is a premium service for those skiers who want to get the best of the mountain; its dynamics are suitable for families, groups of friends or kids, as for individual riders or skiers. A guide will pick you up from your residence or hotel, and accompany you (and your family) to the base of Cerro Catedral, help you out with the logistics and passes, and finally get onto the first ski lift to start our adventure...

### ISLA EXPERIENCE

Isla Victoria has a universe of natural attractions and unique places. Sailing across Nahuel Huapi's crystal clear waters we reach the island. Centennial cypresses and coihues woodland and native and exotic fauna will host our every minute. Guests should be at the hotel lobby at 10:00 am. An exclusive transfer will take us to the pier [30 minutes from downtown / 5 minutes from Llao Llao Hotel] where we will board the motorboat to cross the cold waters of Nahuel Huapi Lake up to the millenary island in 45 minutes. There, we will hike the woodlands through inner trails, to watch its varied flora and

fauna and learn about its history. The trails we will follow for about two hours pose no technical challenge, there are no significant slopes; being quiet and with a little bit of luck, we might even spot some deer or pheasant. Lunch will consist of a mountain lunch meal, thrilling to all our senses. Another part of the island remains to be discovered and we do so on the way to Puerto Pampa, enjoying the landscape and we take our time, before embarking for the 30-minute navigation that will take us back to Port.



## ANDES WINE


You will be picked up at the hotel at 10:30 am and will arrive at Bahía López about 40 minutes/ an hour later. A simple 30-minute walk will take us deep into the woodland and to the natural balconies at the Brazo Tristeza of Nahuel Huapi Lake. The journey itself will provide magnificent views over the nearby mountains and ravishing lake. We access another balcony after a short ascent where we will rejoice with the beauty of the Cerro Tronador and its seven glaciers. Those who dare to go a little further can join us and make a 40-meter rappel descent. At the base of the wall, you will enjoy a mountain lunch with Patagonian delicacies and wines. After lunch we'll walk back to the starting point, where we can choose to board Double Adventure Kayaks and paddle through one of the lakes in the area or go straight back to the hotel [if guests are staying at Llao Llao hotel].

## SERENA SUNSET

At 5:30 pm our host will pick you up by the hotel so as to arrive at Port by around 6 pm. We'll weigh anchor once the sun begins to set and sail in between mysterious islands which are loaded with their own history. As these stories begin to enlighten us, the city begins to do so. Eventually we'll stop the engine and be able to relax and listen to the silence, just floating on board. Here, where the waters are calm, we'll share a glass of wine meanwhile the day transforms itself into a dark blue sky filled with bright stars and a toast pays tribute to that moment. Call it a magic trick because very day we are honored with a different scenery, a different sun, a different sky and a different ending. An experience that surely enriches the soul!

## PARAGLIDING

Paragliding is the fastest growing air sport in the world. For many people it is a dream come true! The Paraglider canopy is actually a wing, which flies by using exactly the same aerodynamic effects that keep aeroplanes in the sky. However unlike an aeroplane, the beautiful thing about a Paraglider is that they don't require an engine to stay airborne. Forget the boundaries of airports, the narrow aluminium tube of a passenger jet, and ordinary mortal style flying. Think instead about skimming metres above a remote mountain top in the



## TREKKING

We will meet at the hotel to go to the Llo Llo Municipal Park where we will walk for about half an hour through majestic coihues (Beech) woodlands, surrounded by native vegetation and the occasional exotic plant that will make this tour a colorful one. A forty-minute ascent through mountain cypress woodlands will take us to the vast viewpoint overlooking the Nahuel Huapi Lake. We will return to the bay, where our transportation will be waiting for us.

## KAYAK

Kayaking allows us to reach the most remote and virgin areas in nature, experiencing the Andes from another angle. We will meet at the hotel at 10:00 am and start our adventure. Firstly, a safety security talk by our guide and details on the activity; and then, we're off!

Circuits: Nahuel Huapi Lake, Moreno Lake, Gutiérrez Lake. Circuits are determined according to duration, weather conditions and guest expectations.

## HORSEBACKRIDING

Our host will pick you up at your hotel and drive towards an exclusive Estancia with pristine forests. Once there, a guide who is not only an expert in horseback riding but also in animal communication, will fit you with a helmet and gaiters and provide you with the basic safety instructions. This fabulous ride through centennial woods of coihue, mountain cypress and radial trees around the lake will make you marvel at the spectacular views of the region and feel part of the majestic beauty of our amazing Patagonia.

Back at the Estancia, you will enjoy a mouthwatering homemade meal with local wines and a warm coffee by the inviting fireplace; or a one of a kind tea with sweet homemade pastry.
